

NITK's convocation on Nov 23

MANGALURU, DHNS: The 22nd annual convocation of the National Institute of Technology (NITK), Surathkal will be held on November 23. Addressing media persons on Wednesday, NITK Director B Ravi said the convocation will be held in two parts - for postgraduate students in the forenoon session (10 am to 1 pm) and for undergraduate students in the afternoon session (3 pm onwards).

Indian Institute of Science, Bengaluru, Director Prof Govindan Rangarajan will

be the chief guest for the PG convocation.

Space Commission member and ISRO former chairman A S Kiran Kumar will be the chief guest for the UG convocation.

He further stated that a total of 2,078 students will receive their degrees. The number of students who will receive various degrees is as follows: BTech-1,002, MTech and MTech (research) - 758, MBA, MCA and MSc - 179, PhD-139, BTech-195, BTech Honours-5.
